Templates Include:

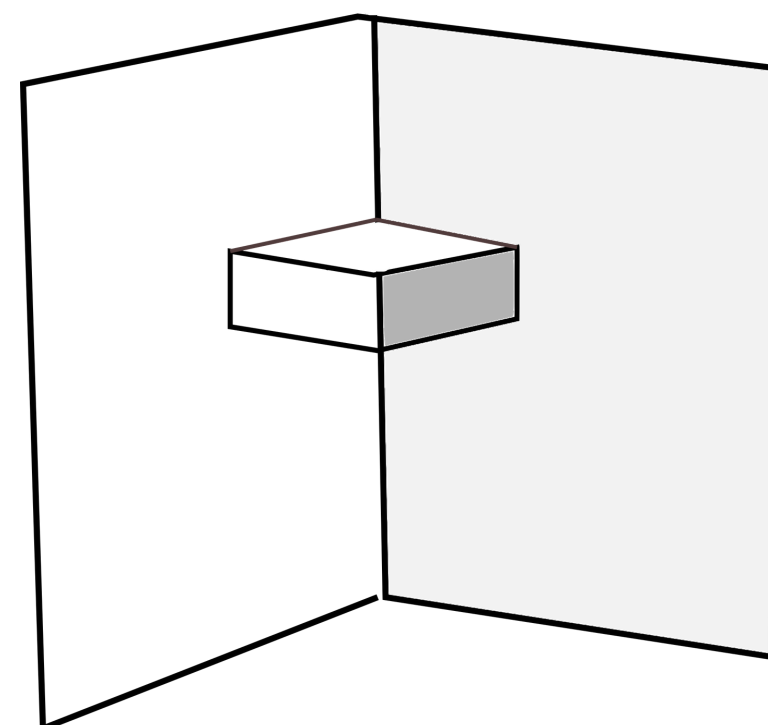
- A Pile of Gifts

Template Key

- Fold Line
- Cut Line



You will need:

- A4 Card/Paper
- Crayons, Markers or Pencils
- Scissors
- Sticky Tape or Glue

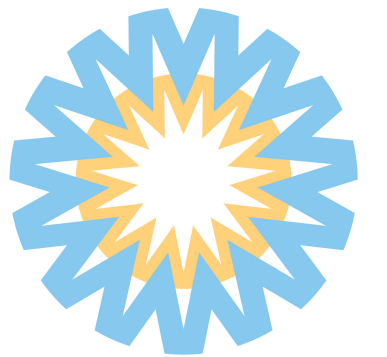
How to Make:

Most of the templates are made in a similar way

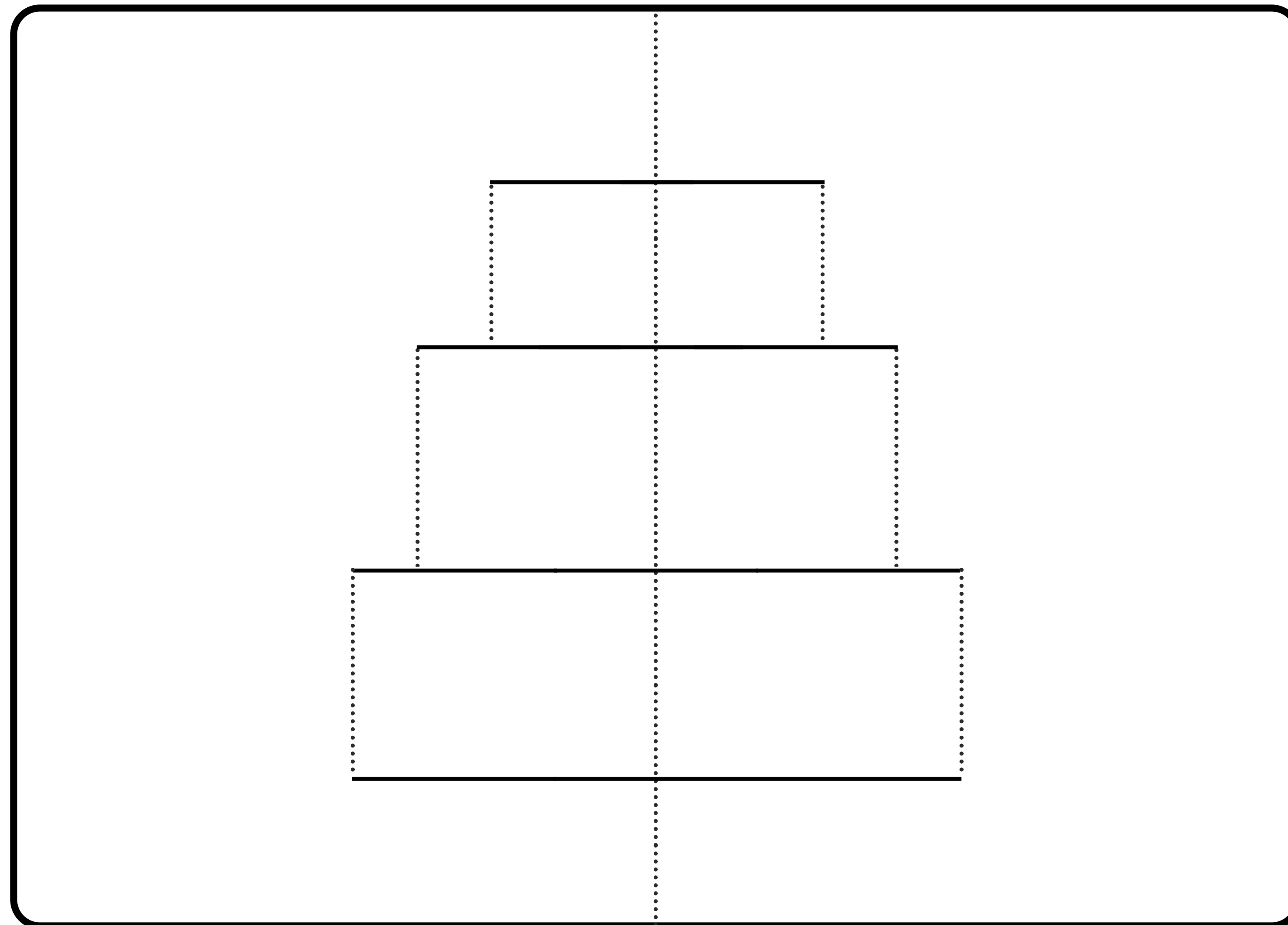
1. Print out the templates you want to make on card/paper.
2. Cut along the solid lines around the outside of the card.
3. Fold along the centre line of the card (this will make things easier later).
4. Decorate your card.
5. Cut and fold along the other lines on the card. This will create some tabs.
6. Unfold the card. Push the tabs through the centre of the card. If you refold the card in half the tabs should now be inside the card so when you open it they pop-up.

To Make:

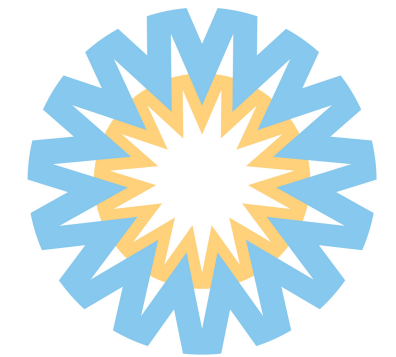
Cut along the solid lines. Fold along the dotted lines.

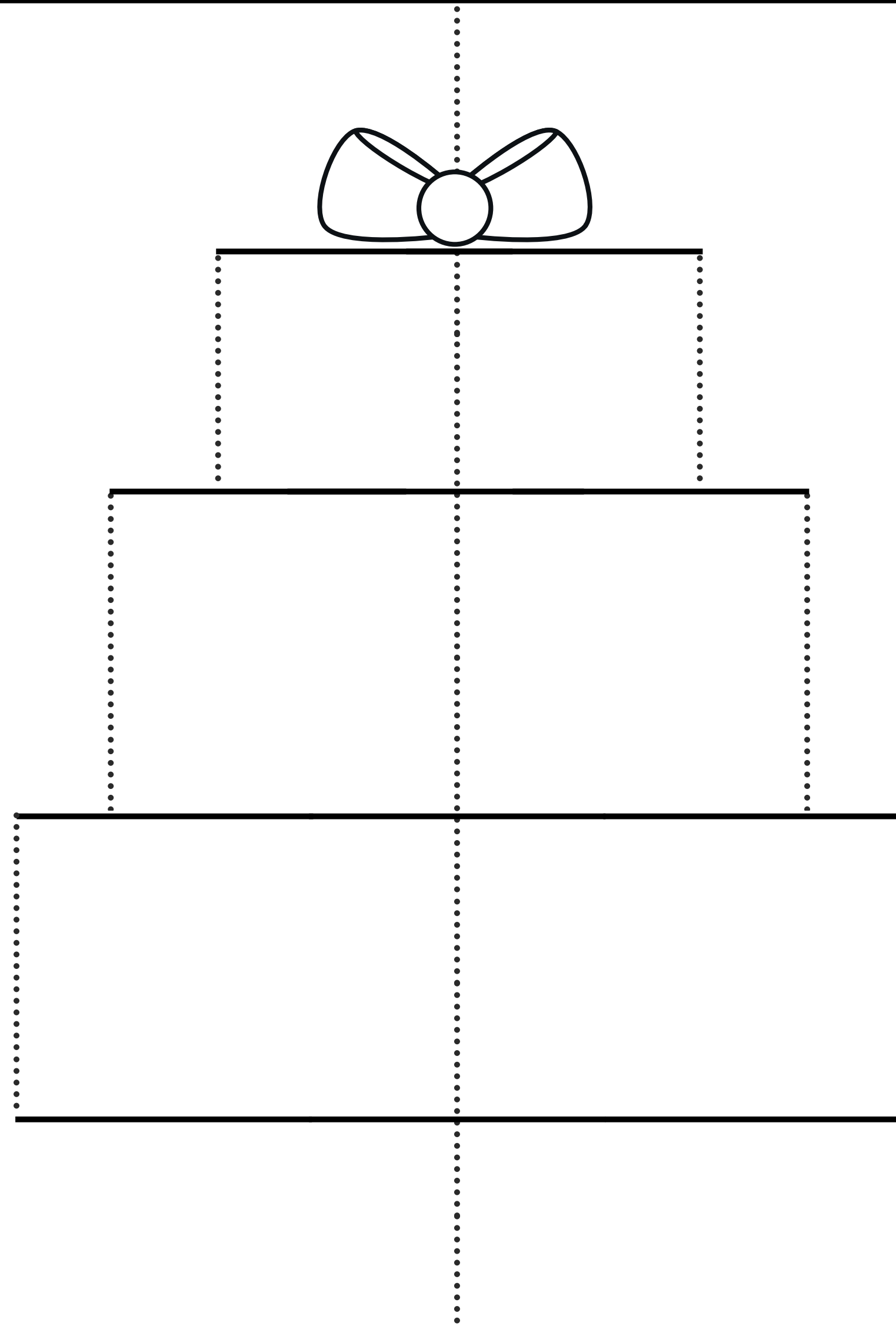

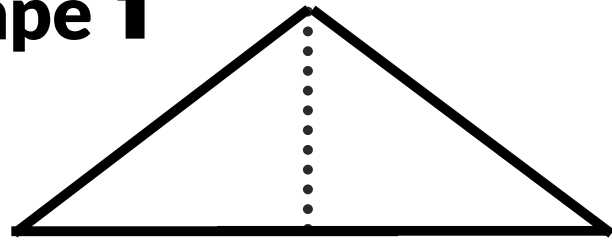

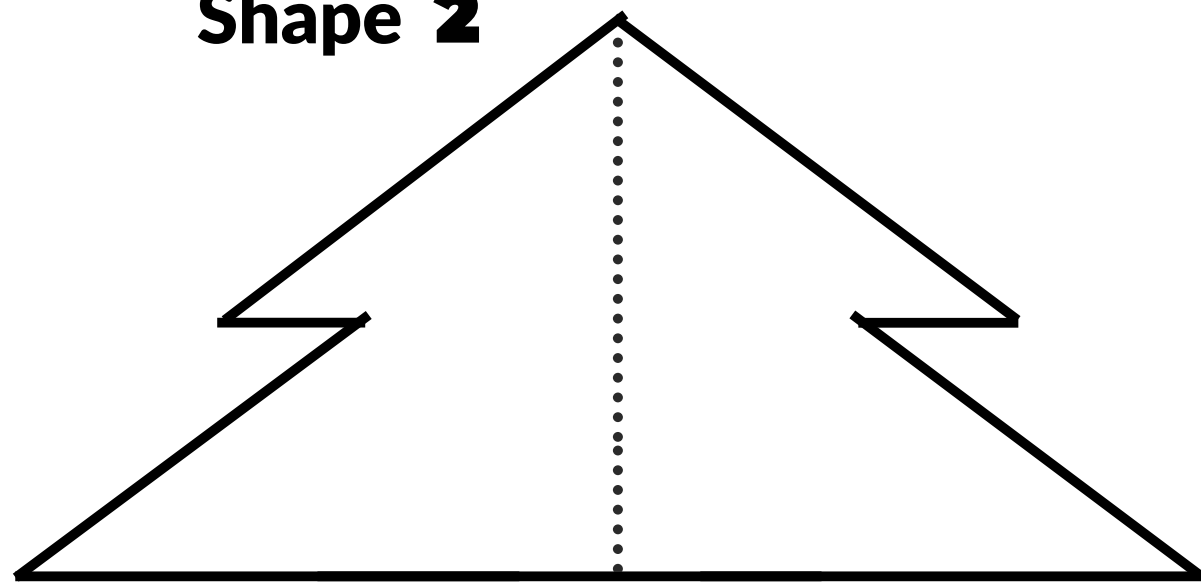


Christmas Tree

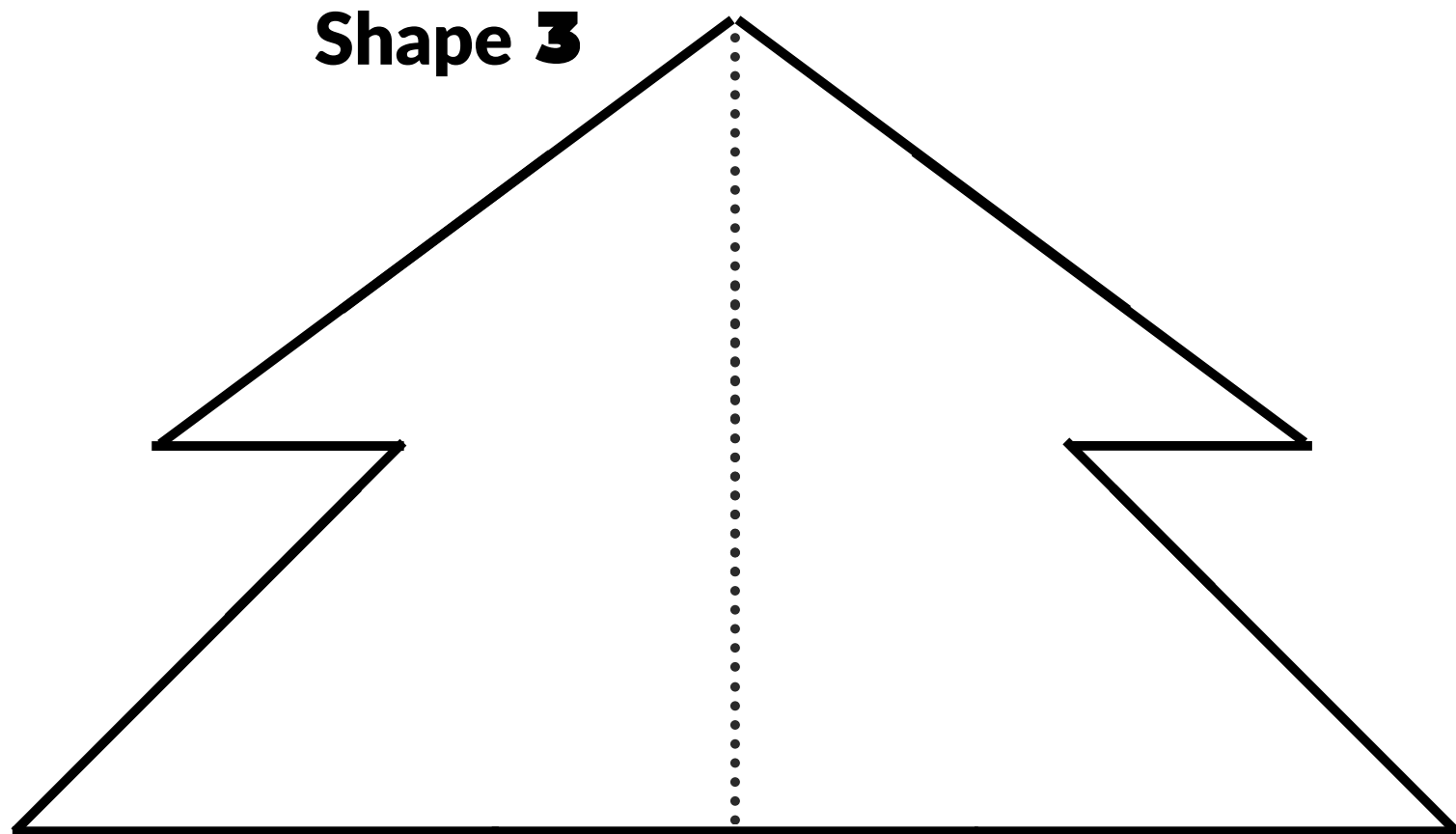
Shape 1



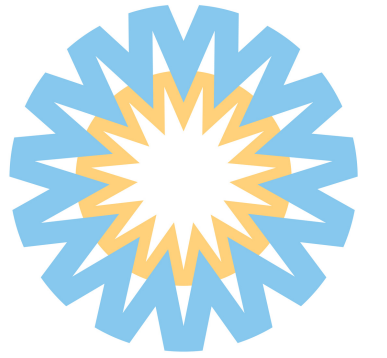

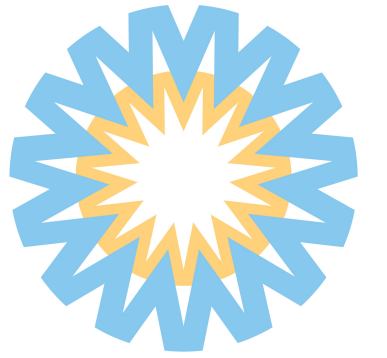
Difficulty: Medium

This card has two elements the main card with tabs and shapes for the tree sections.

To Make:

1. Cut along the solid lines around the outside of the card.
2. Fold along the centre of the card (dotted lines).
3. Cut and fold along the other lines on the card.
4. Unfold the card. Push the tabs created through the centre of the card. If you refold the card in half the tabs will now be inside the card.
5. Decorate your card and shapes 1, 2 and 3.
6. Cut out the shapes and fold along the dotted line.
7. Line up the bottom edge of tab 1 with the bottom edge of shape 1 and glue into place.
8. Do the same for tab/shape 2 and 3.

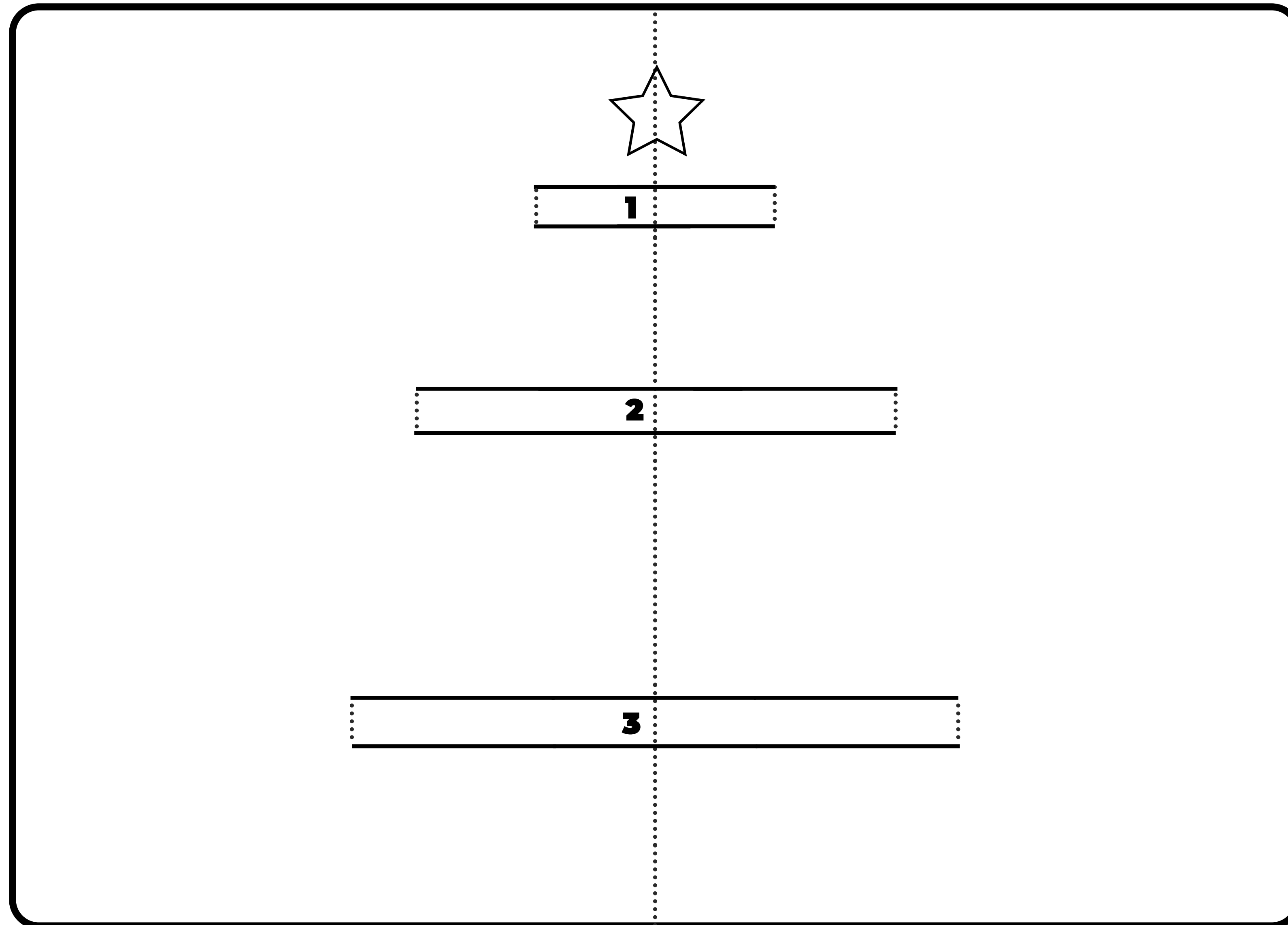
To Make:

Cut along the solid lines. Fold along the dotted lines.

The numbered tabs match with the shapes on the previous page.

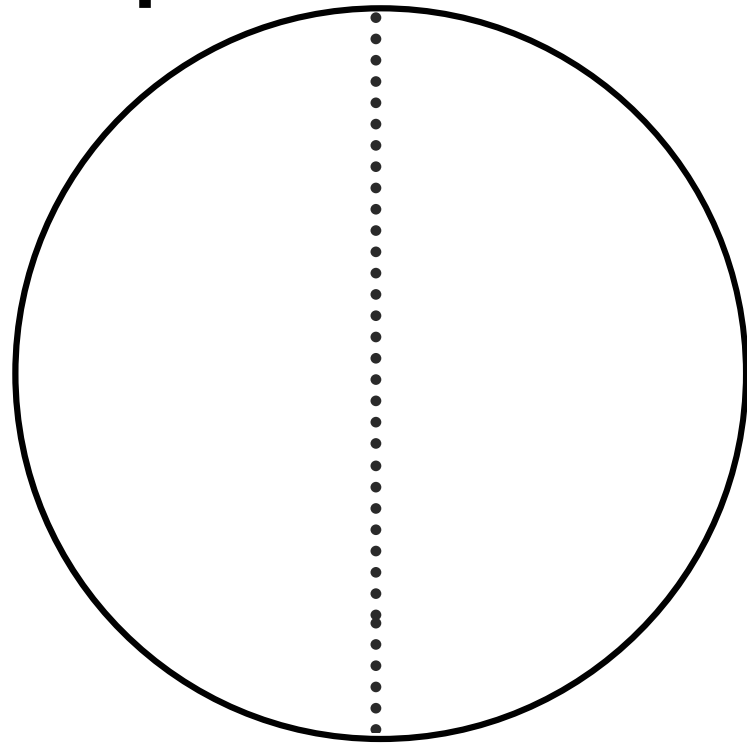
Top Tip:

If your tree shapes do not fit, make you tabs longer or trim the shape edges.

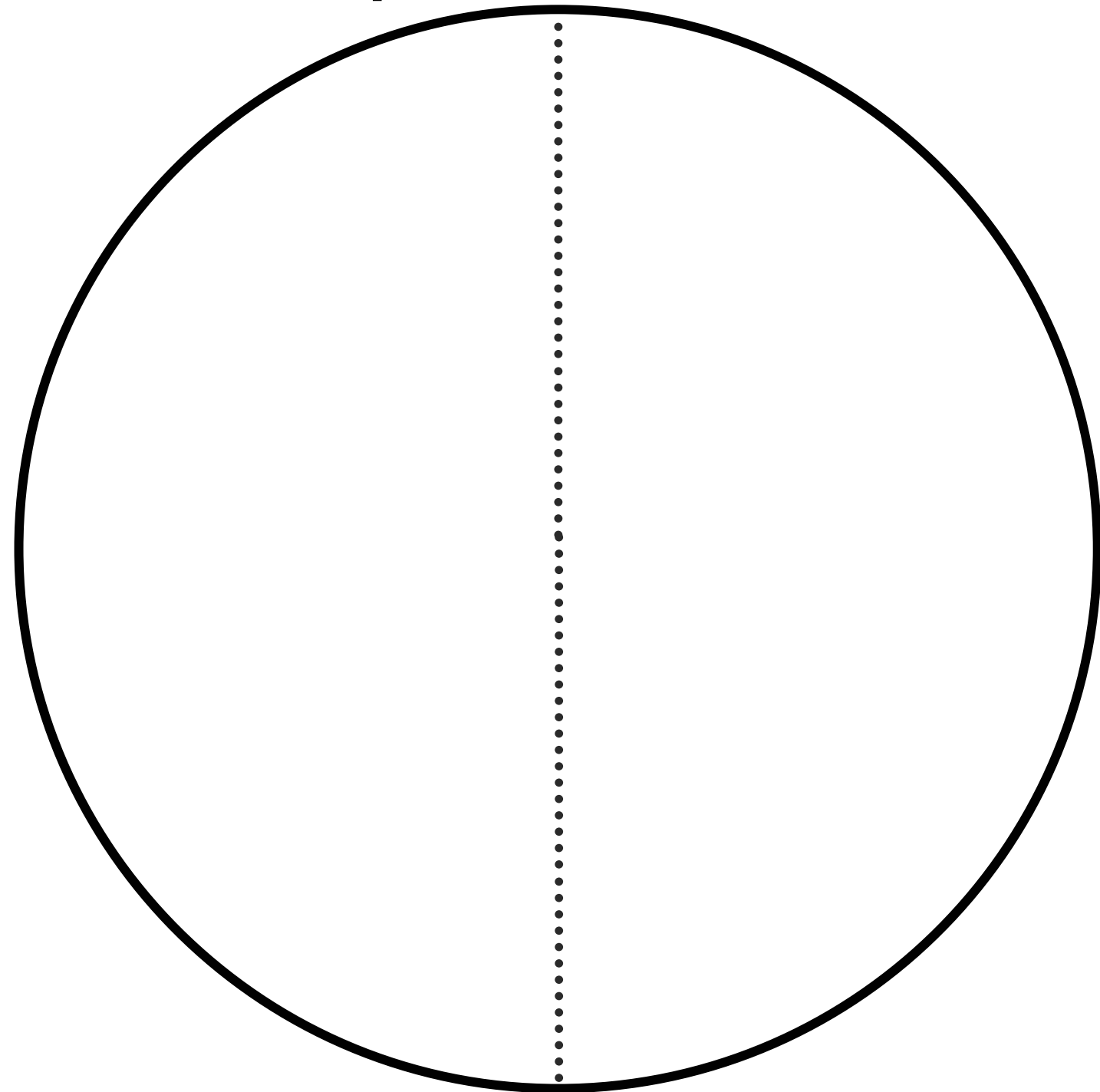


Snowman

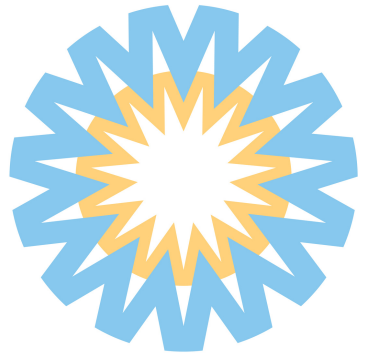

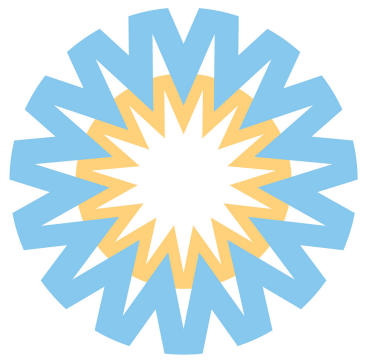
This card has two elements the main card with tabs and shapes for the Snowman.

To Make:

1. Cut along the solid lines around the outside of the card (on next page).
2. Fold along the centre of the card (dotted lines).
3. Cut and fold along the other lines on the card.
4. Unfold the card. Push the tabs created through the centre of the card. If you refold the card in half the tabs will now be inside the card.
5. Decorate your card and shapes 1 and 2.
6. Cut out the shapes and fold along the dotted line.
7. Line up the centre of the shape 1 with tab 1 and glue into place.
8. Do the same for tab/shape 2.

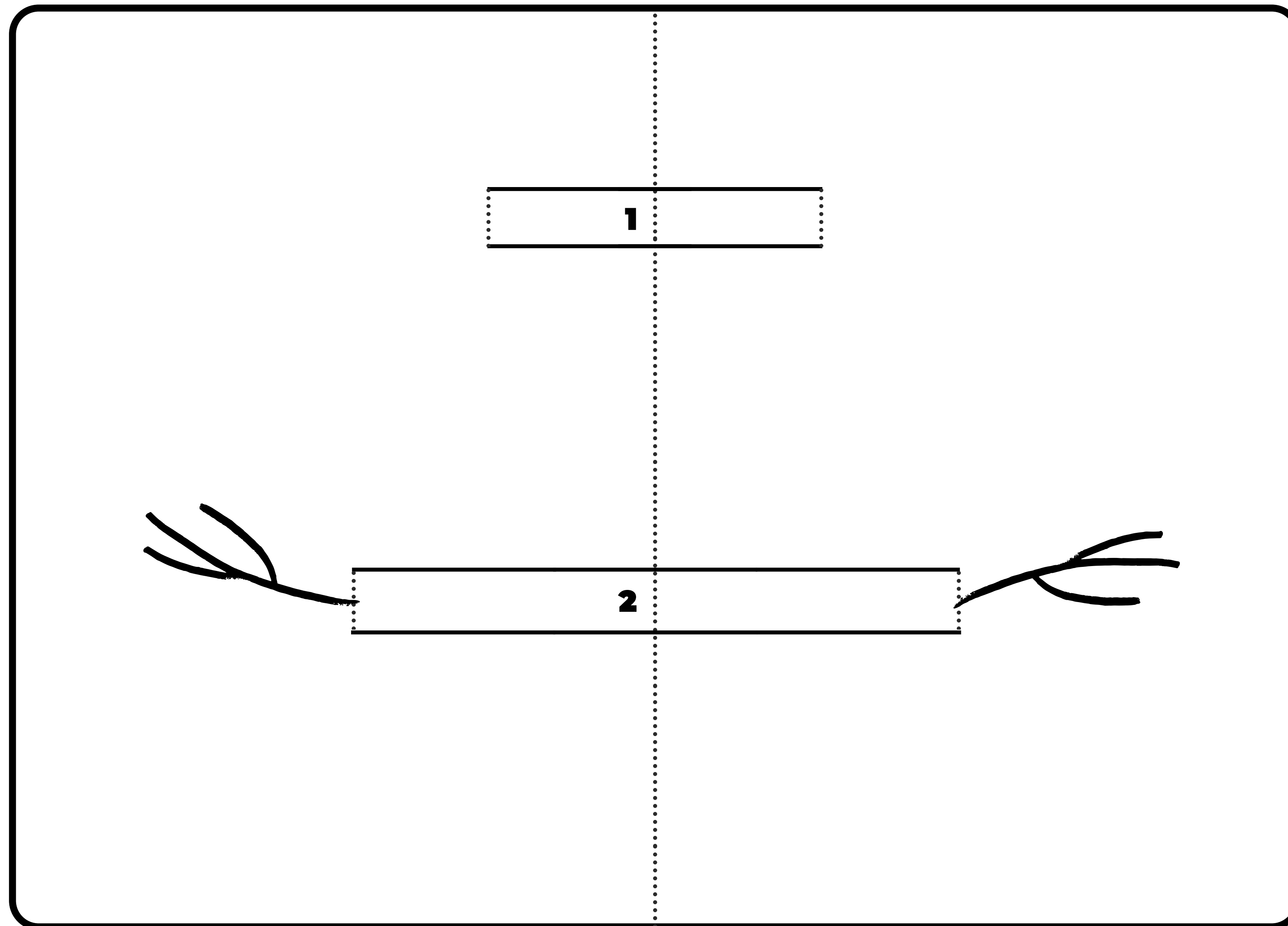
To Make:

Cut along the solid lines. Fold along the dotted lines.

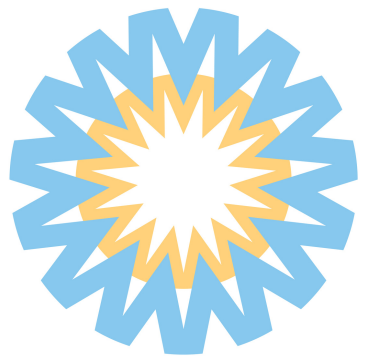
The numbered tabs match with the shapes on the previous page.

Top Tip:

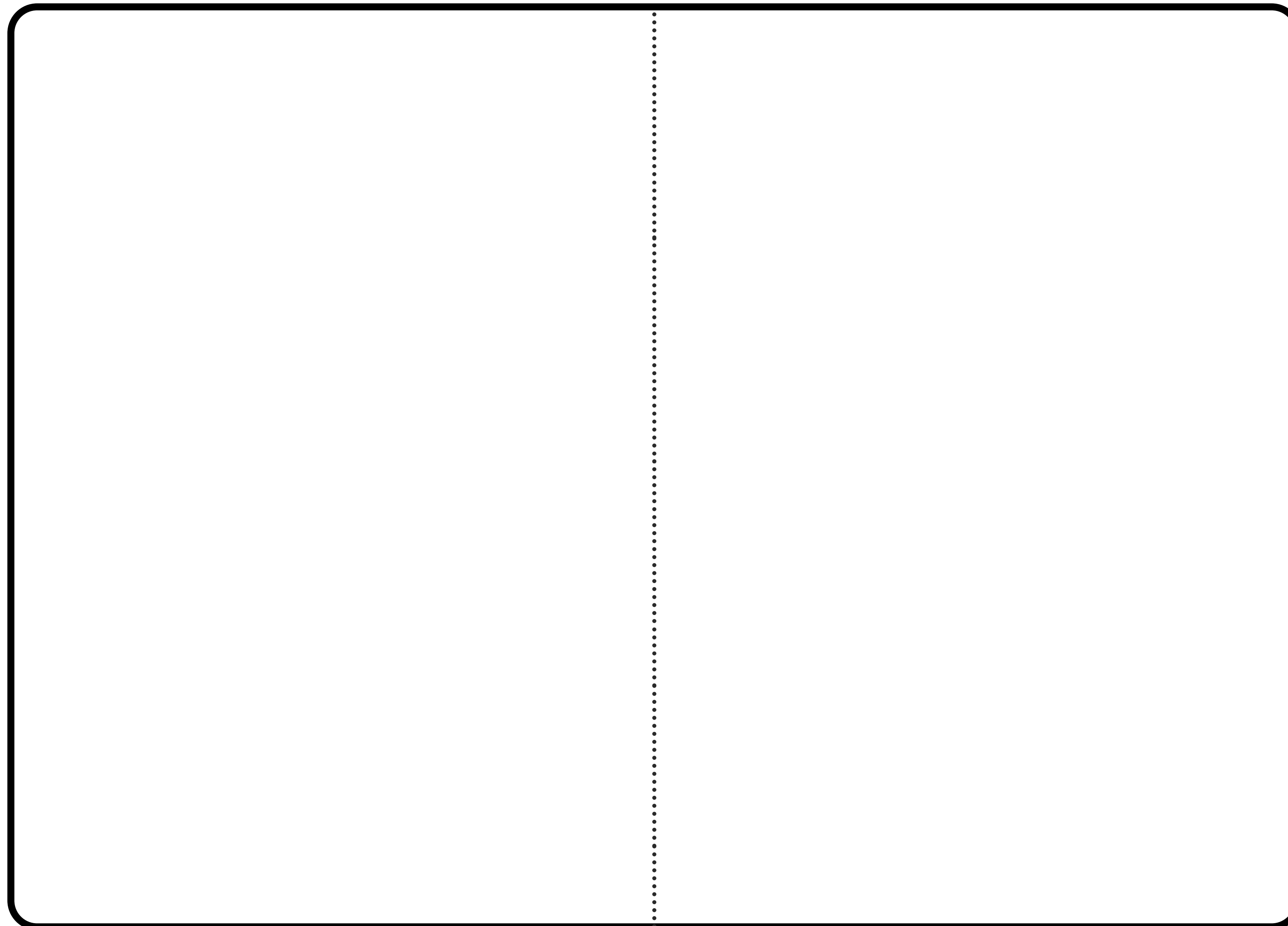
Instead of drawing a hat or scarf on your snowman, why not design them and then stick them on?
